"Our first goal is to set up an organic European co-production, and we aim to find partners from Italy and Germany, potentially Switzerland or Austria, to bring in shooting and studio facilities as well as co-writers, co-directors, cast, HoDs and further crew, while we are open to other countries as well. In terms of post-production we are particularly interested in talking to potential partners from Belgium. We are also looking for a sales agent, broadcasters and further financing partners."

Company Profile

BLONDE is an Athens-based company that feeds on its mixture of international creative input. It has produced over 30, often nationally and internationally awarded documentary and feature films, such as *MOON*, *66 QUESTIONS* by Jacqueline Lentzou (2021) and *DIGGER* by Georgis Grigorakis (2020).

The company also produces high-quality TV series, including award-winning titles such as *TEHRAN* for Apple TV+ (Emmy award for Best International Series in 2021) and three seasons of the acclaimed crime series *THE OTHER ME* (*ETEROS EGO*, 2019-2023), and has also provided service production for numerous successful titles in recent years.

Creator's & Director's Profile

Born in Greece in 1977, Elina Psykou studied filmmaking and sociology in Athens. She has directed and written successful feature films, such as *THE ETERNAL RETURN OF ANTONIS PARASKEVAS* (Berlinale Forum 2013) and *SON OF SOFIA* (Tribeca 2017, Best International Narrative Feature Award), and is currently developing her third feature *PATRIMONIAL FEARS AND OTHER ILLUSIONS*. Her first documentary *STRAY BODIES* is in post-production. Elina founded the film production company Jungle Films, and in 2021 she produced the critically-acclaimed feature *PACK OF SHEEP* by Dimitris Kanellopoulos.

Synopsis

Greece, 1973: A shipowner murders his German wife on their private island. The Coroner, who serves the Greek junta, is called upon to cover up the crime. He is accompanied by his assistant and nephew. Initially a simple observer of events, the Coroner's assistant becomes more and more involved in the surrounding political turmoil and proceeds to kidnap the shipowner's son, an act that he believes will bring social justice. After sending a letter to the press alleging political motives, he sets off to Italy with his Italian lover. When the authorities discover his hideout, he manages to escape, but his girlfriend is fatally injured.

From the political awakening and the illusion of revolution, the Coroner's assistant ends up alienated and corrupted, blackmailing the Coroner: If he doesn't hush up his involvement in the kidnapping, the original forensic report that states the shipowner's wife was murdered will be leaked to the press. At the same moment, the junta sends a tank to the Athens Polytechnic to suppress the ongoing anti-establishment student uprising.

Creator's Note

In 1973, in the midst of a dictatorial regime, the Coroner and his entourage cover up a femicide; in other terms, an entire patriarchal society covers up violence and corruption. Precisely 50 years later, it is estimated that more than 50.000 femicides are committed annually worldwide. However, no one will ever know the true number since many of them are not recorded as such, but disguised as accidents or suicides. Concurrently, it is now clear that the cover-up of violence and corruption is linked to the recent rise of far-right as well as fascist movements around the world.

Within this context, rather than representing this historical period, we will use it as a source of inspiration for a modern take, to dialogue with contemporary society in a straightforward and surprising way, and assume a profoundly political and unexpectedly fresh perspective. This dialogue with today, combined with the intense atmosphere of the literary original and the images created by the narrative and the characters—their lust, guilt, fear and fantasy—led me to proceed with this mini-series adaptation.

Head Writer's & Director's Profiles

Thomas Ritter studied philosophy in Zurich and Montréal and completed his additional film studies at the Zurich University of the Arts in 2015 with a Master's degree in screenwriting. Thomas was the head writer on the miniseries *PRIVATE BANKING* (2017) and also wrote for the international Degeto series *THE NET – PROMISED LAND* (*DAS NETZ – SPIEL AM ABGRUND*, 2022). His latest work *EARLY BIRDS* is the first Swiss Netflix co-production and premiered at the Zurich Film Festival in 2023.

Fulvio Bernasconi studied political science at Geneva University and directing at the Swiss film school ECAL. He wrote and directed several fictions for TV and cinema, including *OUT OF BOUNDS* (*FUORI DALLE CORDE*, Silver Leopard for Best Actor for Michele Venitucci at Locarno in 2007). Fulvio is also one of the creators and the director of the internationally acclaimed and widely distributed series *BANKING DISTRICT* (2017).



Synopsis

2024. When a dead body is retrieved from Lake Lugano, the world of the ambitious but struggling journalist Anna is turned upside-down. All her life she was told that her Sicilian father, Antonio, left their family when she was only a little girl. Now she must learn that he was brutally murdered. She is furious and determined to find the truth.

She sets off to investigate her late father's work as an art expert, also known as "Il Curatore" for the infamous duty-free warehouse and his shady affiliates in Lugano. As she discovers evidence that points to the greatest art theft of the 20th century in Palermo in 1969 – later coined "Il Furto Del Caravaggio" – she's onto a scoop. Possibly her breakthrough as a reporter!

But her family wants to let bygones be bygones and her beloved brother desperately tries to steer her off her path. Her curiosity stirs up dirt from the past and Anna's articles are read in Palermo as well. They call the Mafia to the scene. Anna's sources are brutally assaulted. But she won't give up and finds an unlikely ally in a young cop. Together they solve a puzzle that connects her to the very origins of her traumatic family history. Anna finds the painting and discovers her family's dark secret.

Head Writer's Note

Our series connects a spectacular true crime case – the unsolved theft of one of the most famous paintings in the world – with a fictional story centered on a dysfunctional family and their improbable entanglement with a ruthless criminal network. Spanning from Sicily to Switzerland, our thriller combines a touching family drama with a propulsive plot full of surprising, at times shocking turning points, to create an exciting narrative close to the characters' inner conflicts. It explores the traumatic disintegration of a seemingly normal family through their inextricable dependence on criminal circles, which – like the palm tree spreading northward due to climate change – extend from Sicily way beyond the "palm line". A disintegration, tragically caused by our investigative protagonist, the unknowing daughter of a Mafioso.

Gebbe's prior directorial credits include her second feature *PELICAN BLOOD* (2019), starring Nina Hoss and winner of numerous awards, and her feature debut *NOTHING BAD CAN HAPPEN* (2013), after her own script, which won the German Film Critics' Award and the Bavarian Film Award, amongst others. Katrin Gebbe is currently shooting her first English-language series *A THOUSAND BLOWS* for Disney+ (created and written by Steven Knight).



Synopsis

Paris, 1780: The French Revolution is just a blink away when pious Renée gets married to one of the most notorious libertines of her time, the Marquis de Sade. After a lifetime of oppression, she vows vengeance on her mother, who knowingly “sold” her to improve her social status. Renée and de Sade team up to destroy their family’s reputation and shake up the bigoted hierarchy. Soon, the royal police is at their heels. When de Sade loses himself in his sexual fantasies and crosses forbidden lines, he is caught and sentenced to death. Renée frees him from prison, but once on the loose, de Sade runs off with her younger sister, Anne. Her mother is finally defeated when Anne dies dejected and lovesick. Renée realises she is trapped in another, even more abusive affiliation with de Sade, who becomes a slave to his ideals of freedom. As aristocratic heads get chopped off by a hungry crowd, Renée escapes with her daughter into an unknown, but finally self-determined future.

Creator’s Note

Who would have guessed that literary history’s *enfant terrible*, the Marquis de Sade, was married? Our miniseries tells the true story of Renée, the initially pious noblewoman-turned-accomplice to the infamous Marquis de Sade. The unconventional lovers become the 18th century’s Bonnie & Clyde, with Renée as the avenging angel of a whole generation of women traded and trapped in a humiliating, patriarchal system. A story about female sexual empowerment told through the gaze of three women: devout Renée, her beautiful hungry-for-life younger sister Anne, and their dominating mother La Présidente. It will be a thrilling and sexy journey that reveals the dangerous connection between sexuality, power and hierarchy.

WOLVES

Arash learns that his lover was executed for being homosexual. Overwhelmed by rage and despair, in the middle of a new wave of uprising, he arrives in Tehran to seek revenge with the help of two friends, and soon, the three get sucked into the city's gloomy underworld.

Writer's & Director's Profile

Berlin-based Iranian filmmaker and artist Sina Ataeian Dena is a lecturer at the German Film and Television Academy dffb and UdK Berlin University of the Arts. His video art and photographs have been exhibited in renowned contemporary art museums in Germany. His short rotoscope animation *ESPECIALLY MUSIC* won Best Film in the international competition of the Tehran Short Film Festival in 2009. In 2015, his debut feature film *PARADISE* was nominated for the Golden Leopard in competition at Locarno and won the Prize of the Ecumenical Jury and the Art Peace Award, among multiple festival participations and awards around the world.

Synopsis

After Mahmood's execution in Tehran, his boyfriend Arash, serving on the Afghanistan border, seeks revenge. He joins forces with his former lover Reza, a TV star, and Mina, a member of the globally renowned hacker group Anonymous, supporting the new uprising and declaring a cyber war against the Iranian regime. The trio's primary target is Karimi, a key player in Mahmood's execution. As a first act, they want to sell the opium that Arash smuggled to get the funds to build a bomb. Reza's fame opens some doors. As they navigate Tehran's underworld, moral doubts about their violent path arise. But they get sucked into the gloomy underworld of criminals, prostitutes and drugs. The border between reality and dream melts. When the critical moment of revenge finally arrives, Arash hesitates to push the button. A green VW races onto the scene and shoots Karimi, revealing that the high-ranked collaborator of the dictatorial regime had more enemies beyond their circle.

Writer's Note

In any society of an ideological nature, diverse lifestyles are pushed underground, facing relentless attacks and the denial of their existence. *WOLVES* unfolds in the ambiguous reality of contemporary Tehran, where people who live a double life start to rebel. Amidst repression and anger, a theocracy justifies bizarre and inhuman outbreaks. This accessible universal story explores how oppressed individuals create their parallel realities, as the main protagonist Arash loses his grip on perception. The rotoscope animation technique parallels this cruel concept of reality, as the visual outcome is neither fully realistic, as a filmed image might be, nor fully artificial, like with animation. It is both at the same time.




Accompanying Sese in a modern world she no longer comprehends is Rai, an insecure security guard whose blood she feasts on upon awakening and now follows her around like a lovelorn puppy. And Clara, a gender-bending polyamorous vampire hunter who'd rather bed Sese than fight her. All journeys end where lovers meet, but until she finds Bel, Sese must try to understand what went wrong with their love and survive a vampire establishment set to destroy her. If her broken heart doesn't beat them to it.

Creator's Note

Poor Sese. Vampirism made her irresistible, but she only has eyes for Bel. Like many mortals who love and aren't loved back. What happens when love is taken away, how do you find meaning? Is it possible to retain your sense of self when you're part of a couple? Is there room for romance in our narcissistic world? Cassavetes said: "To have a philosophy is to know how to love and know where to put it. I need my characters to analyze it, talk about it, tear it apart, hurt each other. That's all I am interested in: love." Nowadays a woman interested in romantic love feels passé, but I do believe sex and love in the broadest sense are still the only reason this life is worth living. That's why I want to study it, tear it apart, and maybe, kill it.

Synopsis

South Africa, 1800. Jonker Afrikaner (40) works in servitude for a racist Dutch farmer in the Northern Cape. One day, fueled on by the injustice of his situation, Jonker snaps. He shoots his master, robs his house and equips his fellow labourers with arms. Together with a group of runaway slaves, he flees British and Dutch rule over the Orange River, aiming for Namibia. Caught in a shootout with British Cape Police, Jonker is wounded, and earns himself the nickname the Man with the Crooked Arm.

Searching for salvation in Namibia, Jonker and his men attempt to build a church. But their use of guns forever changes the dynamics of the region, and Jonker becomes a notorious bandit. After sacking a village he forces strong, self-sufficient Ana (25) to marry him, and despite circumstances, love grows, tempering Jonker's bloodlust. After a botched robbery where Jonker kills a man, he decides to adopt his son.

Meanwhile, German missionary Hahn (44) miraculously survives a shipwreck along Namibia's treacherous Skeleton Coast. Traveling inland, he attempts to set up a church in the image of his Kaiser. This pits him against Jonker, who must resist the encroaching missionary and the threat of his colonial empire. But not before grappling with his own demons. He will eventually be forced to choose between his son and continuing along his destructive path.

Creator's Note

We explore Namibia's infamous figure, Jonker Afrikaner, a Nama or Oorlam—a mix of Khoikhoi, Europeans, and diverse slaves. Like the Boers, Oorlam lived as semi-nomadic gunmen, forming states in South Africa and Namibia. In this thrilling series, characters impose their flawed order on an ungovernable land, delving into their darkest natures. Rooted in Herero oral history, this cinematic series project merges decolonial activism, history, mysticism, and personal/tribal gnosis. The filmmaker's family also hail from Ovitoro, where many Herero, Nama and German battles took place. This adds a unique perspective, envisioning a "new model" for filmmaking.

The second and third seasons focus on the rise of Herero dominance in 1880s Namibia, followed by German colonialism and the subsequent genocide of the Herero. Grounded in local oral history and folklore, this series aims to challenge Western textbook "facts."

Synopsis

Jasna, a renowned math professor and matriarch of the Memišbegović family, has just died. Her daughter Selma and her cousins, Lejla and Mersiha, are welcoming grieving relatives and friends. When an unfamiliar woman called Hana unexpectedly arrives and talks about Jasna as a once promising *schlager* singer, Selma begins to question whether she truly knew her mother. Searching for answers, she starts investigating family (hi)stories, and finds serious discrepancies and loopholes in the narrative she once was taught to believe.

Across eight episodes and two time periods (1969/1970 and 2023/2024), the story mirrors Bosnian female identity rooted in Islamic and socialist traditions and values, challenged by unfulfilled promises of post-liberal capitalism. The Pandora's box that Jasna held closed releases repression, betrayal, rape, and even murder. Yet, as each cousin would affirm – they're just an ordinary family.

Creators' Note

Bosnia and Herzegovina in the time of socialist Yugoslavia significantly brought about formal equality, yet women's biographies and histories remained largely untold. Today, in a post-truth society, we are losing our sense of context and what came before us; the continuity of women's stories is fragmenting once again.

This female family chronicle, told through two periods, serves as a bridge between two centuries, two eras, and two societies, shedding light on the hidden lives of Balkan women. Female secrets in both periods touch on taboos such as sexuality, violence, and mental health, questioning the notions of feminism and individual freedom. What would happen if all these secrets were not secrets at all?

S.O.L. is a darkly-funny thriller about a rich man who wants to make his mark on history by "saving humanity" but instead almost ends it with a do-gooding mission that turns dangerous in farcical ways.

So they had to be rich. They had to be egotistical enough to think they could make decisions that impact us all without oversight. So I thought it would most likely be a man from the West. And so, Stefan Alström was born.

We live in a nexus of vested interests, large and small. It's a Good Thing to give money away, until someone tries to profit from an act of charity. It's a Good Thing to manufacture clever technology, until people actually use it. It's a Good Thing to want your estranged family back, until the actions you take to do that put their lives at risk. *S.O.L.* considers urgent questions: how do you do the Right Thing, and what is the right thing to do in a connected, chaotic and fearful world?

Synopsis

Summer 1996 in a small village in the Basque Pyrenees. Four 12-year-olds play in the woods and enter an abandoned mine. Lost inside, they find a businessman kidnapped by the terrorist group ETA. They want to warn the police but fail to do so when they discover that one of their fathers is involved in the kidnapping. Wanting to do the right thing, the gang decides to free the man. They steal a car, but it runs off the road and sinks into a lagoon. The children manage to get out but not the businessman. So they make a pact of silence to conceal the crime.

When 15 years later one of them tries to commit suicide, the group reunites for the first time since the incident. Needing to free themselves from the guilt of murdering a man, they decide to confess their crime, but when they return to the village and the police take the car from the lagoon, they discover that the boot is empty. As the news reaches the businessman's daughter now living in France, she decides to speak the truth about that night in the summer of 1996: her father survived and returned home, but due to his financial crimes and possible reprisals from the terrorists, he forced his family to keep up his disappearance – an imposed silence that turned the girl into the imposter she never should have been.

Creators' Note

We wanted to create a story of significant dramatic depth, with echoes of terrorism and great emotional dilemmas, but from a different point of view: that of twelve-year-old children. It is a coming-of-age series set around a historical and recognisable context but stripped of any political connotation and with an aura of adventure that turns into a drama and then a thriller.

It is a story about loyalty, the weight of guilt, remorse and the need to accept the consequences of your actions. But it is also an homage to that moment in life in which friendship means everything. But how many of us have bonded through a vow to conceal a crime?
